Please respond to the Introduction and the Performance Expectations applicable for the award category in a one-page narrative, which explains your reasons for making the nomination (**do not** attach additional pages of narrative).

Introduction

Please provide a concise description of the nominee. You may attach a resume (two-page maximum) for individual nominees. If the nominee is not a resident of Kentucky, briefly give clear evidence that the nominee is closely related to the state.

Performance Expectations

Your nomination will be reviewed using the following performance expectations as applied to each award category description:

- Personification of the value of the arts
- Nominee has demonstrated their/its support of artists and organizations in providing arts activities

Milner Award

- List the nominee's outstanding philanthropic, artistic or other contributions to the arts.

Artist Award

- Describe the nominee's lifetime achievement in the arts.

Business Award

- Describe the nominee's outstanding interest in and support of the arts.

Community Arts Award

- Describe the positive impact the nominee has in the community through the arts.

Education Award

- Describe the significance of the nominee's contribution to arts in education.

Folk Heritage Award

- Describe the nominee's outstanding effort to perpetuate and promote Kentucky's unique artistic traditions.

Government Award

- Describe the significance of the nominee's support for the arts through government action.

Media Award

- Describe the nominee's commitment to bringing the arts to the attention of the public.

National Award

- Provide evidence of the nominee's achievement of national prominence in the arts.

Supporting materials may be included with this nomination, but **will not** be returned (*please do not submit audio or video recordings*). It is recommended that supporting materials be limited to 15 pages/pieces. Letters of support, reviews and other photocopied materials must be on standard-size (8 ½ x 11 inches), single-sided white paper only.
