

Kentucky Crafted: The Market is open to the public during the following hours:

Parking

There are more than 10,000 parking spaces available within a 10-minute walk of the Lexington Center. Lexington Center offers a drop-off and pick-up area on High Street/South Side of Lexington Center. Limousines, buses and cars will be allowed to drop-off and pick-up in this area, but no vehicles will be permitted to park.

Accessible Parking

Parking accommodations for guests with disabilities are available in Lexington Center's High Street and Manchester Street parking areas.

Information Desk

The information desk is located in the atrium near the front entrance. For questions about the facilities, the show or market exhibitors, or emergencies, please talk with staff at the information desk.

Accessibility Services

A limited number of wheelchairs are available at the information desk for checkout with a valid I.D. and credit card number. Kentucky Stage performances feature American Sign Language interpreters.

Purchase Holding Area

Market patrons who are also attending the UK basketball game can take advantage of our free purchase holding area on Saturday only. Purchase items at The Market before the UK game and we'll hold them in a secure area for you to pick up when the game is over. Items must be picked up before The Market closes at 7 p.m. For more information on the free purchase holding area, visit the information desk.

Quiet Space

A quiet area is located in the front of the exhibit hall near the hands-on activities area and restrooms. Nursing mothers, tired guests or anyone needing a rest can access this room.



Food Services

The concessions window is located at the back of the exhibit hall and will be open during show hours. Outside of The Market, the Shops at Lexington Center food court offers free Wi-Fi and a variety of casual dining choices. Shrinkable Backpack Charms



Every child needs a special charm to make their backpack or other bag stand out! These shrinkable designs incorporate art and science. Participants will use their imaginations to create designs on a plastic medium, and then watch as their designs shrink right before their eyes to create a thick, hardened charm, which can be displayed on backpack zipper pulls or as a keychain.

Josephine Sculpture Park

Printmaking and Bookbinding



Participants will meet and work alongside local artists, creating their own works of art that they can take home or contribute to the community sculpture. Josephine Sculpture Park is collaborating with Starpointe Studio and Hound Dog Press to create a project that incorporates elements of printmaking and book binding into the creation of a large community sculpture project.

Schedule of Performances Saturday, March 5

10 a.m.

LaMay & Reese, *Americana*

Joe LaMay and Sherri Reese, favorites of folk and bluegrass audiences alike, have performed together since 1998. With their carefully honed blend of traditional and original songs, guitar and old-style banjo, and powerful harmonies, LaMay & Reese deliver an expressive, powerful performance.

11 a.m.

Butch Rice, *Americana*

Butch Rice writes about what we can all identify with: love and loss. With every tune, the heartstrings resound as if the guitar has been in the hands of too many, slightly bruised and worn, but stronger in character. An ASCAP award winner, Rice leads you on a melancholy journey of remembrance with his sweet, rich falsetto.

Noon

Colin Grant-Adams, *Celtic*

National touring artist Colin Grant-Adams, originally from Oban, Scotland, performs songs of the British Isles, American folk and bluegrass music, adding elements from his own musical experiences of 30 years, to create a refreshingly spirited sound uniquely his own. Drawing from traditional, contemporary and acclaimed original songs, Grant-Adams brings to light the Scottish influences on American folk and bluegrass music.

1 p.m.

Dale Pyatt, *Americana*

Multi-award winning songwriter and a recipient of the International Bluegrass Music Association's recorded event of the year, Dale Pyatt has penned songs that cross music genres including Americana, bluegrass, country, roots and even island-style. His high-energy performances bring audiences to their feet and leave them begging for more.





2 p.m.

The Reynolds Family Band, *bluegrass*

The Reynolds Family Band has been singing and playing bluegrass and gospel music at festivals, concert halls, churches and other venues throughout Kentucky and surrounding states for about 20 years. Heavily influenced by traditional bluegrass styles of Bill Monroe, The Stanley Brothers and Flatt & Scruggs, this unique band also weaves a bit of Grand Ole Opry style country and a touch of the blues into their music.



3 p.m.

No Tools Loaned, *bluegrass*


A well-oiled machine in the acoustic music arena, No Tools Loaned appeared on the scene around the turn of the 21st century. Since that time, they have polished their craft into a masterpiece of team work and originality. No Tools Loaned is one of the area's premier bluegrass bands, and they appear frequently at popular regional festivals. Their unique mix of original songs, hot new bluegrass tunes, classic rock and folk ballads and western swing numbers puts a fresh face on the traditional bluegrass sound.



4 p.m.

Hog Operation, *bluegrass*


Steeped in Kentucky's rich music tradition, Hog Operation gives high-energy performances created by the cross-pollination of many American roots music styles including blues, bluegrass, Celtic, country and rock. Hog Operation plays a style of supercharged bluegrass music using traditional instrumentation — guitar, banjo, bass, fiddle and mandolin — that accompany smooth vocal harmonies.



5 p.m.

Arthur Hatfield & Buck Creek, *bluegrass*

Arthur Hatfield, like his band, began learning and honing his skills performing bluegrass music at an early age. Formed in 1994, Arthur Hatfield & Buck Creek are known for their tight vocal harmonies. Each member brings his or her own individual talents and years of experience on vocals, banjo, mandolin, guitar, bass and fiddle to the group's classic bluegrass arrangements.



6 p.m.

The Rick Oldfield & Curnie Wilson Band, *bluegrass*

One of the best new bluegrass bands to hit the scene in a long time, The Rick Oldfield & Curnie Wilson Band has a sincere love and passion for that old-time traditional sound that blends soulful vocal harmonies with top-notch instrumentation in the style of bluegrass music pioneers.

Sunday, March 6

10 a.m.

Marcus Wilkerson, *Americana*

Deeply steeped in the classic songwriting traditions of the early Civil Rights Movement and the Peace Movement, Marcus Wilkerson uses his gift to convey the tone and emotion in a story. A passionate singer, his guitar style is rough and rhythmic at one moment and light and languid the next. Wilkerson's performances are exciting and transformative.

11 a.m.

Greg Schaber, *blues*

Instrumental virtuosity, soulful vocals, memorable original tunes, and fresh takes on old traditions are all phrases used to describe Greg Schaber's music. His work reflects a deep understanding of blues and related American folk forms and creates a compelling, robust performance.

Noon


Keltricity, *Celtic*

Keltricity performances feature traditional, contemporary and eclectic Celtic-influenced music from Ireland, Cape Breton, Scotland, England, Brittany, New England and French Canada. This four-member group, comprised of accomplished musicians with backgrounds in various musical genres from traditional Irish bands to Scottish and New England contra dance bands to classical, rock and jazz, combines their varied experiences to provide some of the most innovative music around.

1 p.m.

Mitch Barrett, *Americana*

Mitch Barrett has created a contemporary understanding that reaches beyond his Appalachian heritage to reveal a broader musical prowess. A recipient of some of the country's most prestigious songwriting awards, his rousing performances combine original and traditional tunes on the dulcimer and guitar with imaginative reflections on his life and the traditions of his mountain home.





2 p.m.

The Afrophysicists, *world*

The Afrophysicists presents a lively world music travelogue of Afro-pop, Latin, Samba and Afro-beat among others. From the inspirational grooves of West Africa to the pulse of Latin clave, this ensemble covers a lot of ground with their mighty horns and strong rhythmic drive. Their songs are completely infectious, displaying incredible musicianship, while maintaining world rhythmic versatility and welcoming strains of funk and soul.



3 p.m.

Heath & Molly, *roots rock*

Heath & Molly blend vocals, acoustic guitars and various percussion to create a homegrown, original, folk music experience with the sonic value of a much larger ensemble.



4 p.m.

Appalatin, *world*

Appalatin's sound is the unique blend of several cultures: part Latino, part Appalachian, but most importantly world. The group's musicians interpret traditional folk music in their own style and perform fearless original songs while merging a variety of acoustic instrumentation, including classical and steel string guitars; traditional native wood flutes and pan flutes; harmonica; mandolin; charango (Andean ukulele); bass; and myriad percussion instruments, congas, bongos, cajon, maracas, cowbell and guiro.




Floor Plan
