## PARKING

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING

## FOOD SERVICES



## NATIVE REFLECTIONS: VISUAL ART BY AMERICAN INDIANS OF KENTUCKY

*Traveling Exhibit, March-November 2020*

The Kentucky Arts Council, the Kentucky Heritage Council and the Kentucky Native American Heritage Commission announce a new exhibit featuring visual art by Native American artists living in Kentucky, juried by a panel of Native Americans. Goals of this exhibit are to share expressions of Native Americans' experiences in Kentucky today, and recognize that Native American individuals, families and communities have lived in Kentucky all along. This exhibit debuts at The Kentucky Crafted Market, then travels to various galleries and host sites across the Commonwealth through November 2020. ## JOSEPHINE SCULPTURE PARK


Josephine Sculpture Park (JSP) is a 30-acre park with over 70 public art installations and walking trails among native habitat, open daily from dawn to dusk in Franklin County. They are committed to getting families outside and connecting with art, nature and community. ## KENTUCKY STATE PARKS – WAVELAND STATE HISTORIC SITE

Waveland State Historic Site is an antebellum house in Lexington, also known as the Joseph Bryan estate, which includes three original outbuildings: a slave quarters, a smokehouse and an ice house. Guided tours of the site focus on the everyday lives of the family and slaves who lived and worked at Waveland in the 1850s.

Staff from Waveland present the “What Is This?” game, in which guests encounter objects from history and try to determine what they were used for at the time. Also, quill pens will be available so that guests can sign, write or draw something special. A costumed interpreter will be on hand to talk about the history of the sites and relay upcoming events.




