ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Parking accommodations for guests with disabilities are available in the Kentucky Horse Park parking lots and labeled with signage.

INFORMATION DESK

The information desk is located near the front doors of the Alltech Arena. For questions about the facilities, the show, or Market exhibitors, please talk with staff at the information desk.

ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

A limited number of wheelchairs are available at the information desk. An American Sign Language interpreter will be on the Market Stage during performances. All restrooms on the grounds are wheelchair accessible, and ramps give access to all buildings.

FOOD SERVICE

The concessions stations are located at the front of the exhibit hall, along with food trucks on the arena floor. Both will be open during show hours. There are several restaurants in Lexington and Georgetown located within driving distance of the Kentucky Horse Park. See the information desk for recommendations.

RECYCLING

Arts for All Kentucky provides arts and education programs that allow people with disabilities to fully participate in the arts.

Activity: Create your own paper puppy pet. Using paper and markers, you will fold, crease, and color to create your origami dog. Participate in this community art project and learn more about bringing Arts for All programming to your school or community.



Bluegrass Discovery Center (also known as London Children's Museum) is an inclusive space where children of all ages and backgrounds can engage in hands-on learning experiences that help foster creativity, curiosity, and a lifelong love for learning.

Lexington Children's Theatre (LCT) is a professional, nonprofit theater dedicated to creating arts experiences for young people and families. With our home theater in downtown Lexington and our Touring Company that travels all over Kentucky and beyond, we serve over 120,000 young people every year.

Activity: Join the Lexington Children's Theatre for a fun activity based on "Go, Dog. Go!" as part of the second-annual "One Picture Book, 1 Lexington" — a partnership among Lexington Children's Theatre, First 5 Lex, and the Lexington Public Library encouraging families across Lexington to read books together.



LexPhil believes in the transformative power of live orchestral music and envisions a culture of curiosity for the creation and performance of great music and the essential role it plays in a vibrant community and education system.

Activity: Build an instrument that makes dog sounds. The LexPhil MusicLab is a portable studio that combines electronic and acoustic instruments and other technology for a fun, hands-on experience that provides an opportunity for participants of all ages and abilities to make music while simultaneously learning about the science of sound and electricity.

The Kentucky Historical Society (KHS) was formed in 1836 by a group of prominent Kentuckians intent on preserving the history of the Commonwealth. We educate and engage the public through Kentucky's history to meet the challenges of the future.

Activity: Create your own unique "stained glass" suncatcher using tissue paper and laminate sheets. Glass art has been used to decorate our sacred spaces, such as churches, and has allowed artists to create intricate sculptures through glass blowing.

The Kentucky Folklife Program has a mission of documenting, presenting, and conserving the diverse traditional culture and heritage of the commonwealth. Folklife Program staff are here to help you get to know the folk artists and think about your own folk arts and traditions.

The Kentucky Arts Council supports folk artists like these through the Folk and Traditional Arts Apprenticeship program, which helps mentor artists teach apprentices who are members of their community or cultural group. They share skills and techniques — as well as the cultural knowledge surrounding their art form — so their traditions can continue to grow.

The Homer Ledford Award Presentation **Saturday, March 8, at noon Eastern**

The Kentucky Folklife Program, based at Western Kentucky University, began presenting the Homer Ledford Award in 2007. Named after the influential stringed instrument maker who lived in Winchester, this award is given every other year to a Kentucky luthier who is celebrated by the communities of musicians they serve and demonstrates outstanding craftsmanship and mastery of making and setting up instruments for excellent tone and playability.

This year's Homer Ledford Award goes to luthier Arthur Hatfield of Hatfield Banjos in Glasgow, Ky.

The award will be presented on the Market Stage Saturday at noon, where Arthur will share stories and tunes that highlight his artistic excellence. He will set up shop and talk with visitors in the Folklife Zone all day Saturday.

THE MARKET STAGE

The Market Stage is home to live music by some of the commonwealth's most exciting performers. Selected in recognition of their artistic excellence, all the stage performers have been chosen by a panel of performing arts professionals to participate in the Kentucky Arts Council's Performing Artists Directory and are available for bookings in performance halls, libraries, classrooms, community centers, and other locations by request. Stop by the arena floor and enjoy the show!

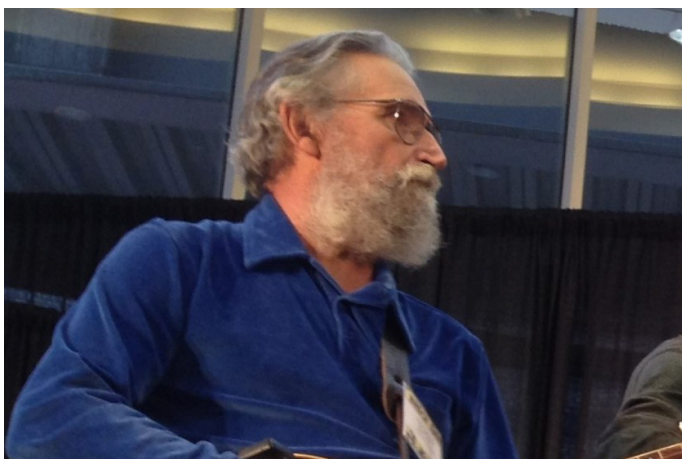

SWIFT SILVER, AMERICANA

Anna Kline and John Looney are the heart of Swift Silver. Their collaboration spans the great expanse of the American songbook with influences drawn from the redemptive strains of gospel, the drawling tremolo of rhythm and blues, and the raw twang of the mountain landscape.

CORNMAIZ STRING BAND, OLD-TIME

CornMaiz is a nouveau old-time family string band featuring original music; traditional, old-time tunes; and unique versions of some famous cover songs. The band features clawhammer banjo, mandolin, guitar, bass, fiddle, and three-part harmonies as well as some flat-footing and clogging.

HOG OPERATION, BLUEGRASS

Steeped in Kentucky's rich music tradition, Hog Operation's high-energy performances are created by the cross-pollination of many American roots music styles, including blues, bluegrass, Celtic, country, and rock. The band plays a style of super-charged bluegrass music using traditional instrumentation — guitar, banjo, bass, fiddle, and mandolin — with accompanying smooth harmony vocals.

APPALATIN, TRADITIONAL AND ORIGINAL WORLD

Appalatin's sound is the unique blend of several cultures: part Latino, part Appalachian, but most important world. Performing original music and interpreting traditional folk music, the six-member band uses all acoustic instrumentation that features classical and steel string guitars; traditional Native wood flutes and pan flutes; harmonica; mandolin; charango (Andean ukelele); bass; and a myriad of percussion (congas, bongos, cajon, maracas, cowbell, and guiro to name a few).

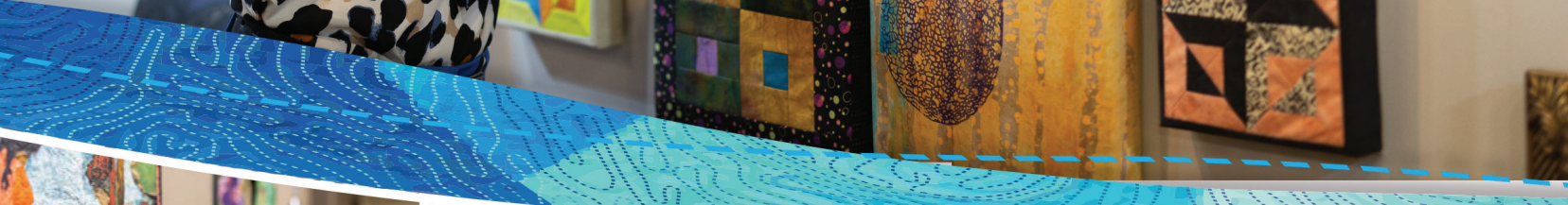
