- Work samples demonstrate, creativity, originality, and accomplished technique in the chosen media (10 points)

Assessment (20%)

- Strategies to measure the impact of the residency on all participants (10 points)
- Strategies to help teachers incorporate content from the residency into future lesson plans for continued learning (10 points)

Accessibility and Fostering a Culture of Belonging (20%)

- Explanation of fostering a culture of belonging of Residency Programming (10 points)
- Instructional Strategies and Resources to Engage Students with Disabilities (10 points)
